



Remote Learning Information and Expectations

As we continue to prepare for the reopening of school, we want to provide some general information to families who have indicated their student (s) will be learning remotely. We are grateful your child will have access to the learning that will be happening in school. The classroom teachers will be providing/posting the specific schedule for the class; however, the student will be available to receive live virtual instruction between 8:10 – 3:10 p.m. each school day. Students who opt for this mode of learning will be provided with synchronous learning experiences, independent work, and opportunities to meet one-on-one or in small groups with teachers. Students will engage in the same content as students learning in-person and will be assessed using the same criteria. Each teachers' schedule will be posted and indicate the virtual meeting time.

- Be present and on time for virtual meetings. Students who don't attend will be marked absent; lateness will also be documented.
- Be prepared with materials and books as needed.
- Be an active participant by having video and audio on at all times. Music, television, video games etc. that would distract students should not be on during the synchronous learning experience.
- Wear appropriate attire. Students may wear their SJS school uniform or clothing appropriate for out of uniform days. Hair should be clean, neat, and combed. Hairstyles should be within the uniform code.
- Completed assignments, homework, tests, and quizzes within assigned time frame or due date.
- Adhere to the technology acceptable use policy outline in the SJS Handbook
- Students regardless of the mode of instruction (e.g. in-person or remote) must adhere to school policies regarding the use of technology. Unacceptable uses of technology include violating the rights or privacy of others by photographing, recording or filming an individual without consent.

We ask that you and your child review the following information that you both sign and return the printed and signed copy of this when you come to school for material and book pick up on Thursday, August 27th.

The school will within reason:

- Provide books (paper or electronic) necessary for the student to participate in instruction
- Teachers will post in a reasonable time frame the schedule and any necessary adjustments
- Provide/prepare necessary materials for student utilization in learning
- Establish procedures/timeline for student submission of work
- Provide Zoom information for student access of class daily

The parent/family will:

- Ensure the student has a device (fully charged) and reliable internet access to enable full participation
- Set up a learning space for the student with all their materials that is quiet and free of distractions
- Pick up materials as necessary from school
- Print all posted/provided materials for student completion

The students (with the support of parents depending on the age) will:

- Be ready to learn each day
- Attend all virtual instruction throughout the day
- Be attentive to learning
- Have snacks or take breaks during time indicated by teacher so as to not be distracted
- Work independently on assignments and projects
- Engage in group work as indicated by teacher
- Participate in all special area classes
- Join classmates for class meetings or other social-emotional learning
- Submit work through designate submission platform (indicated by the teacher)

Families will be able to request in-person learning at the end of the first or second trimester. Requests will be evaluated based on the space and the current guidelines related to health and safety.
