ST. JOSEPH SCHOOL

St. Joseph School inspires each child to discover his or her unique gifts as they grow and transform into young people of character, faith, and wisdom. Based on a proven curriculum, the school's program taught by our dedicated faculty empowers children to continually challenge themselves. We go beyond the basics to nurture the best in each child.

HISTORY Founded on the grounds of St. Joseph Parish as a one-room schoolhouse in 1856, the original structure of St. Joseph School



was destroyed by fire and was rebuilt in the aftermath of the Civil War. With many of the Irish quarrymen who settled here having served in Texas during the war, the area of Cockeysville including the St. Joseph campus became known as "Texas, Maryland." Built with a foundation of stone from the nearby quarry, the new facility opened in 1868 with two large classrooms that were shared by eight grades.

FACULTY/STAFF Our faculty is one of the greatest strengths of St. Joseph School. These dedicated and credentialed professionals nurture a love of learning in our students and encourage each child to realize his or her full potential. It's the ministry of Catholic educators to embody the faith in everything they do.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

WHAT MAKES A CATHOLIC EDUCATION SPECIAL? At St. Joseph School, we believe it is the high standards, the moral foundation and the positive, compassionate energy that our students are immersed in every day.

PRE-K PROGRAM Our preschool program fully engages the family in the child's educational journey. Following the Archdiocese of Baltimore curricula and licensed by the Maryland State Department of Education, the Pre-K program is developmentally appropriate for our youngest learners and prepares a smooth transition to elementary school. Students enjoy the essential elements of a variety of subjects including religion, mathematics, science, art, music, physical education, Spanish, and multi-media technology.

ELEMENTARY (K-5TH GRADES) A variety of strategies and projects are used for students in these grades that include analyzing, writing, summarizing, and critical thinking. For example, in math, students develop number sense beginning with an emphasis on basic math facts. Manipulatives also are used to facilitate concept development and logistical reasoning, and to apply mathematics to problem solving. In language arts, students progress from basic writing skills to full expression, from the ability to read to a love of reading. Specialized instructors in art, music, library, technology, Spanish, and physical education supplement instruction by classroom teachers.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH-8TH GRADES) Students in middle school learn in a departmentalized setting taught by faculty who specialize in particular subject areas in a cross-curricula team approach. Middle school students continue to pursue accelerated curricula in math, science (laboratory courses), and English. Students learn time management skills, note-taking skills, gain self-confidence and ultimately are prepared in every way for high school.



SJS ACHIEVEMENTS

SJS students earn numerous awards, honors, and scholarships each year including the prestigious Knott Funds Elementary and Secondary Scholarships. The last two graduating classes* received offers of grants and scholarships toward high school of approximately \$500,000. St. Joseph School follows the Archdiocesan Course of Studies as well as the regulations of the Maryland State Department of Education for non-public schools.
